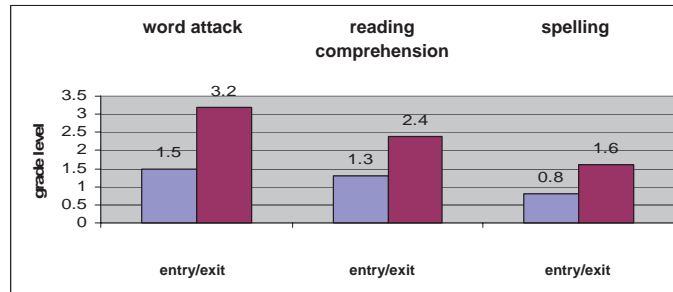

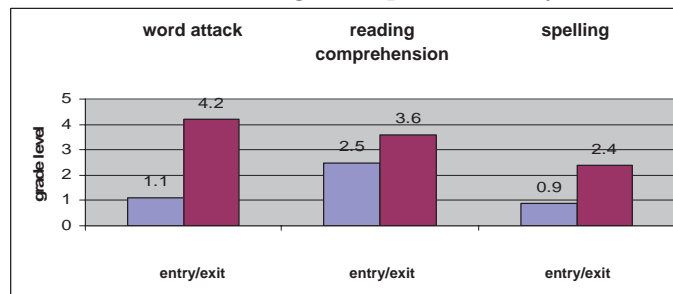
Overall Student Results as of August 2007

These student attended an average 69 hours of a typical 120 hour program.

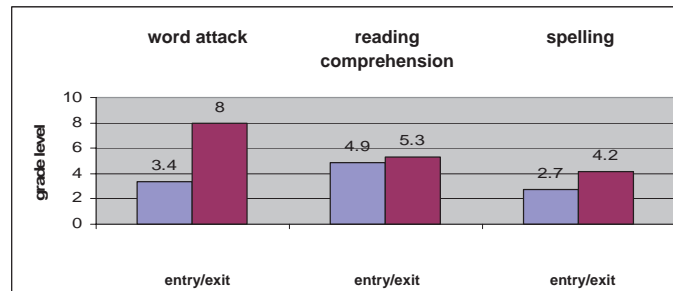
Grade Primary and 1 student results (grade equivalent entry and exit scores):



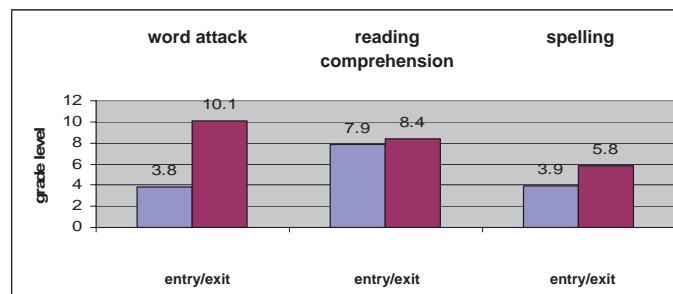
Grade 2 and 3 student results (grade equivalent entry and exit scores):



Grade 4 and 5 student results (grade equivalent entry and exit scores):



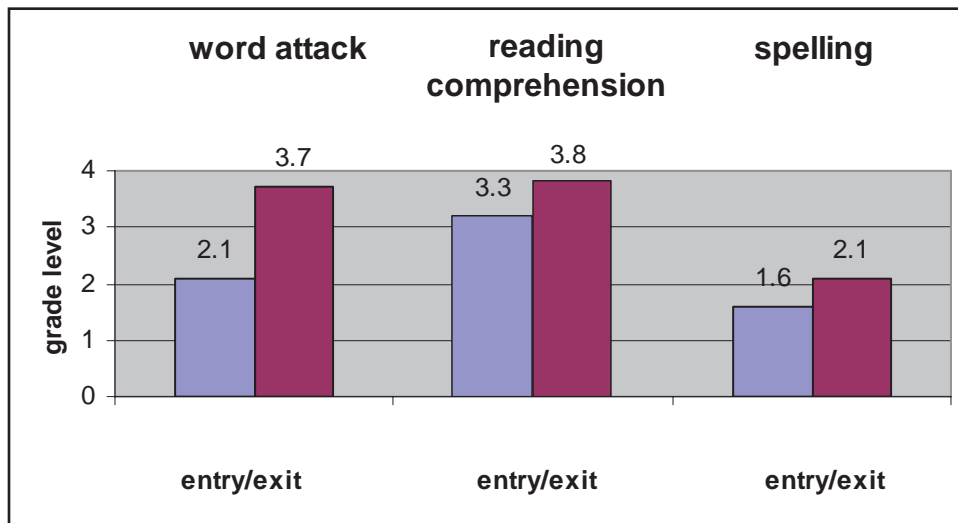
Grade 6 and 7 student results (grade equivalent entry and exit scores):

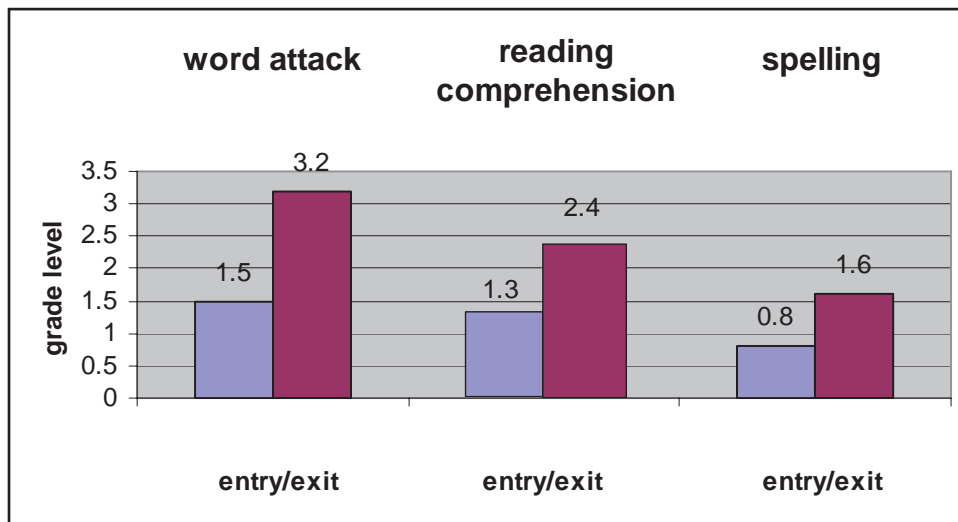
2007 Summer Session Student Results.
