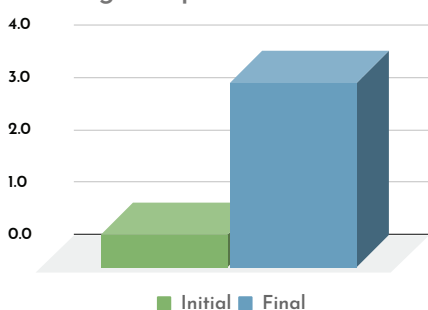

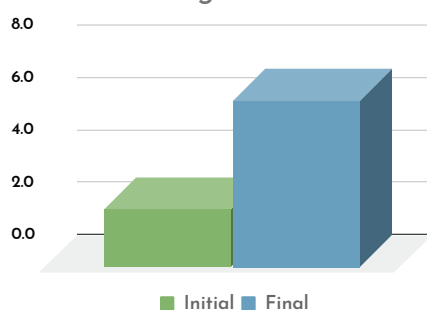

Reading Comprehension: Grade 3



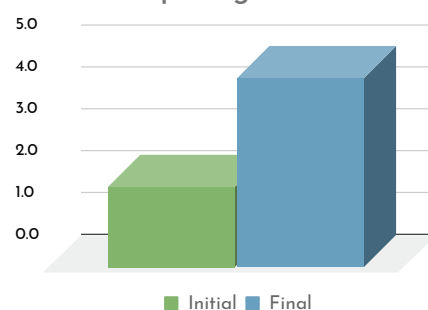
A **3 grade level leap** in reading comprehension for Grade 3s

How long does teacher training take?
